#### HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION SUMMARY

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN - CAUTION - May cause mild eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, open cuts, or sores. In case of contact, flush with water. Get medical attention for eyes. This blended dry fertilizer is a mixture of Urea, Monoammonium Phosphate, Ammonium Sulfate, Muriate of Potash, Iron sucrate, Manganese Sucrate, and Zinc Sucrate.
