2. HAZARDS IDENTIFICATION SUMMARY

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN - CAUTION - May cause mild eye and skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, open cuts, or sores. In case of contact, flush with water. Get medical attention for eyes. This blended liquid nutritional is derived from Calcium Silicate. Nausea and vomiting could be expected upon large dose ingestion. The acute ingestive effects are described as nausea, chills, and diarrhea. Eye or skin contact with these products could cause irritation (particularly in sensitive persons), and respiratory irritation could be expected from the unprotected inhalation of fertilizer mists. Product users should avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact by wearing impervious gloves, long sleeve shirt, long pants, socks and rubber boots. Goggles for eye protection are recommended. Wash thoroughly after handling and using this product.

This product is a clear liquid with mild odor. Primary routes of entry are Inhalation, eye contact and skin contact.

4. FIRST AID MEASURES

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15 to 20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

5. FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

FLAMMABLE LIMITS (LEL & UEL): Not established
EXTINGUISHING MEDIA: Use medium appropriate to surrounding fire. Dry chemical, carbon dioxide, foam, water spray or fog.

6. ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

STEPS TO BE TAKEN IF MATERIAL IS RELEASED OR SPILLED:

Contain spill, absorb liquid with clay or other absorbent material. Sweep up material and place in container for possible land application according to label use or for proper disposal. Check local, state and federal regulations for proper disposal.

7. HANDLING AND STORAGE

HANDLING: Avoid breathing fertilizer mists. Avoid prolonged or repeated skin contact. Eye protection and gloves are suggested when handling undiluted product. Use with adequate local ventilation.

STORAGE: Store in original container only. Keep containers tightly closed. Store in a cool, dry, well-ventilated area, preferably in a locked storage area away from children, feed and food products, and seed. Store at ambient temperatures. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.
